



“Ten” points to “Completion”

1. The **Ten Commandments**, symbolizing God’s covenant were given on Pentecost and carried through the wilderness in the golden *“ark of the covenant”* until the children of Israel entered the promise land and built a temple for its resting place. (Exo 19:14-17; 20)
2. Christ says the kingdom of God is like unto **“ten virgins”** invited to the wedding when the cry is made *“Behold, the Bridegroom cometh, go out to meet him.”* (Matt 25:1-13)
3. Abraham, who God made His covenant with, pleaded for God’s mercy to spare the wicked cities *Sodom & Gomorrah* if there was found from 50 to down to **“ten”** righteous. After the ten was not found, God rained fire and brimstone. (Gen 18:16-18, 23-33)
4. After forty days of proving His resurrection, once Christ ascended into heaven the two tribulation men in white apparel told the disciples to return to Jerusalem and wait **“ten days,”** Sabbath journey, for Pentecost until Christ’s return in *“like manner.”* (Acts 1:9-12)
5. God gave King Hezekiah the sign of the sundial returned **“ten degrees”** backwards “to know when” to go up to the house of the Lord on the third day. (II Kings 20:10-11)
6. *The Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur)* is memorialized **ten days** after *Rosh Hashanah (Trumpets)* on the **tenth day** of the seventh month in the Jubilee year. (Lev 25:8-10)
7. Each of the twelve princes offered a golden spoon of **“ten shekels”** of incense in dedication of the alter when the voice spoke for the mercy seat upon the ark. (Num 7:86-89)
8. After searching the land of Canaan, **“ten spies”** were slain of the plague when they returned with an evil report causing the people to murmur. (Numbers 14:36-38)
9. *“Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him. These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling words, having men’s persons in admiration because of advantage.”* {Jude 1:14-16} (Duet 33:1-2)
10. The cube of 10 (**10 x 10 x 10**) equals **“1,000”** and holds the value of **“Ten,” “Perfect”** (Psalm 37:37), **“Him that overcometh”** & **“All the house of Israel.”** 1,000 = $\phi(1111)$, **“1111”** = “jot/iota” (Mat 5:18), **“The Witness,” “The Foundations,” “Flood.”** 12700 is found at the 1111th position of Pi. Sarah was laid to rest in the Promise Land at 127 (Gen 23:1-2).

11. "And it came to pass **after ten days**, that the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah." {Jer 42:7}, {Dan 1:12}
12. The phrase "and God said" is used **10 times** in Genesis. This phrase shares the value of **343** (7 x 7 x 7) with "The ark of God," which held the **Ten Commandments**.
13. "So he consented to them in this matter, and proved them ten days. And **at the end of ten days** their countenances appeared fairer and fatter in flesh than all the children which did eat the portion of the king's meat." {Dan 1:14-15}
14. "Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; **and ye shall have tribulation ten days**: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life." {Rev 2:10}
15. The first verse in the bible contains seven words in Hebrew, which translates to **ten words** in English.

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. {Gen 1:1}

16. In gematria, the phrase "According to the order of Melchizedek" has a value of "**1010**" in Hebrew and doubles to "**2020**" in Greek.

Language	"According to the order of Melchizedek"	Value
Hebrew	על דברתי מלכי־צדק	1010
Greek	κατα την ταξιν Μελχισεδεκ	2020

The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou [art] a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek. {Psalm 110:4}

17. There are **ten generations** from Adam to Noah, and **ten generations** from Noah to Abraham.
18. God sent **ten plagues** on Pharaoh before He delivered His people out of Egypt.
19. "And he called his **ten servants**, and delivered them **ten pounds**, and said unto them, Occupy till I come." {Luke 19:13}
20. **Number ten** is the first double-digit integer in the **11th** position after the first **ten digits**.
